

## Call for Abstracts: Carnegie Council 2018 Student Research Conference

This conference will be held in Carnegie Council's New York City headquarters on **Thursday, May 10, 2018 from 12:00-3:00pm.**

Presentations will be 10 minutes long and must make a normative argument about international affairs and ethics. Topics can range from human rights, media, international law, justice, accountability, sustainability, and transparency.

There are a limited number of presentation slots available. In order to select the presentations, we ask that all interested candidates submit an abstract of no more than 500 words. **The deadline for the abstract submission is Thursday, April 6th, 2018.**

The best presentation will receive a free year-long membership to the Council's Carnegie New Leaders program, judged by a panel of academic and business professionals.
