## Fall 2020 Arrival and Self-Quarantine Facilities(Hoam) Application Guide

## 1. Summary

This guide contains the application procedure for "Hoam Faculty House Self-Quarantine Facilities", That SNU OIA offers for students who are required to self-quarantine for 14 days upon arrival to Korea but do not reside in SNU dormitories (Gwank Residential Halls). Please note that there may be additional changes in the guidelines and information, and students must comply with the latest version of the guidance at all times

## 2. Arrival Information Questionnaire

## 3. Arrival (Airport to Self-Quarantine Facilities)

All entrants who reside in Seoul must receive a COVID-19 diagnostic test immediately upon arrival, at the local public health center's screening clinics and go under mandatory self-quarantine for 14 days from the next day, regardless of the test result.

Upon arrival, Seoul residents must travel to the local screening clinics that their residential/quarantine address belongs to, via a personal vehicle or specially designated shuttle taxi/bus. (Gwank-gu residents must head to Gwank-gu screening clinic.)

## $\circ$ Arrival Guide (Wear a mask all the time during the travel)

1) Upon arrival, go to the emergency shuttle bus waiting area (Zone 4 for Gwanak-gu), fill out the passenger form, and take the bus. Passengers are only allowed to get off at bus stops designated by the district office.

2) Get off at the local district office (Gwanak-gu Council), and receive the COVID-19 diagnostic test at Gwanak-gu Public Health Center's Screening Clinics.

3) After the diagnostic test, take the specially designated transportation again, and head to the SNU Hoam Selfquarantine facilities. (Please note that <u>you are not allowed to move into Hoam facilities unless you are tested.</u>)

4) You will be given further guidance for move-in and self-quarantine.

## $\circ$ Shuttle Bus Timetable (Subject to change, fare: KRW 16,000)

- Due to the limited operation hours of the district office's screening clinic (tests available to passengers who arrive before 6 pm through the bus #2), you are required to change your flight schedule accordingly

## 4. Self-Quarantine Facilities at Hoam Faculty House

\* Students who will reside in SNU dormitories (Gwanaksa) can apply for SNU dormitories' self-quarantine facilities. (<u>Click here</u>)

For students who will not reside in SNU dormitories and who cannot move into the dormitory quarantine facilities due to late arrivals, SNU OIA offers self-quarantine facilities near the campus, at Hoam Faculty House, on a fee-paying basis. Please read the information below carefully and <u>file an application at least 3 days</u> before your departure from your home country.

Please note that the self-quarantine requirement applies only to new entrants to Korea (including return and reentry to Korea), and therefore, students who are now in Korea do not have to complete it.

## <Hoam Faculty House Self-Quarantine Facilities Operation Plans>

\* If you do not complete the application and fee payment in time, you are not allowed to move into the selfquarantine facilities. Bank account information will be provided at a later time for students who finish the application. \* Due to the limited number of rooms available per day, not every applicant will be accepted; (<u>The maximum number</u> <u>of students who can be admitted to the facility is limited to around 25 persons per day</u>.) We will further notice you in case we are unable to accommodate you on a certain day



□ The total fee for the quarantine period (14 days) would be <u>KRW 1,003,000</u> (KRW 70,000/day and KRW 23,000 for bedding rental) must be paid <u>before moving into the self-quarantine facility</u> .						
□ We highly recommend you to consider the transfer and exchange rate fees for the international wire service fee. Please note that we will refund the surplus amount from the total payment later.						
□ During the quarantine period, it is not allowed to get out of your room. It is not allowed to cancel your stay in the middle of the quarantine (In accordance with the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act). Further notice and instructions will be issued and made available to you at a later time.						
□ In due consideration of Article 15 of the Personal Information Protection Act of the Republic of Korea, the Office of Internal Affairs SNU hereby requests your consent to collect and/or using your personal information. Collected information will be used only for internal references. I hereby consent the collection and/or use of my personal information stated following the survey.

# Reinforced Quarantine of International Arrivals Diagnostic Test & Self-Quarantine

Starting April 1, all Seoul residents entering South Korea must receive

# a diagnostic test immediately upon arrival at their local public health center's screening clinic.

(Applies to all nationality including Koreans, regardless of length of stay)

※ Please bring your passport and airline tickets to receive a diagnostic test at screening clinic.

# Self-quarantine is mandatory for 14 days even if you test negative for COVID-19.

Those without an accommodation or a suitable place will be quarantined in facilities provided by the central/local governments.

(For both Koreans and non-Koreans from overseas, all costs regarding medical treatments will be covered by the government, except for the fees for the facility used for quarantine.)

% Please request for a re-test, if any symptoms show during the quarantine.

※ Zero tolerance for those who violate the self-quarantine procedures (e.g. unauthorized activity)

st Immediate prosecution for those who leave self-quarantine without good cause

Violators may face imprisonment of no more than one year or a fine of no more than KRW 10 million in accordance with the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act. (Non-Koreans may be subject to forced deportation, entry ban, etc. in accordance with the Immigration Control Act)





## Seoul residents entering South Korea may only travel via personal vehicle or specially designated shuttle taxi/bus.

## Personal vehicle (or of guardian's) — Masks required, minimal conversations

Get to the designated screening center of your district's public health center. % Call and check the hours of operation before visiting.

Receive a diagnostic test at the public health center's screening center. ※ Passport and airline ticket required to receive test

Head home immediately after receiving the diagnostic test.

## Self-quarantine for 14 days! ※ Self-quarantine is

mandatory even if the test result is negative.

## Specially designated shuttle taxi (Fare: KRW 65,000 to 160,000; 24-hour operation and fare set by district)

#### Hail a ride at Seoul Taxi Info Desk.

Get off and receive the test at the screening center. % Call the center before visiting. Passport & airline ticket required.

After receiving the diagnostic test, take the specially designated shuttle taxi. ※ Your assigned taxi will wait until testing is complete.

## Emergency Shuttle Bus for International Arrivals (Fare: KRW 16,000)

#### How to use

1,	Upon arrival, go to the emergency shuttle bus waiting area. (Incheon Airport - Terminal 1 [1F], Terminal 2 [B1F])
	Check the bus routes and fill out the passenger form.

(Routes are classified by zones.) Passengers are only allowed to get off at bus stops designated by the district office.

Take the shuttle bus to your local district office. (You may make a request to your district office if you do not 3. have a separate mode of personal transportation.)

Get off at district office and head to your accommodation/ residence. (Follow the instructions of the person in charge 4, at the district office.) [Use of personal vehicles are prioritized; ride the district office vehicle if needed]

# Coronavirus Disease-19 (COVID-19)

# MANDATORY QUARANTINE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL INCOMING TRAVELERS TO REPUBLIC OF KOREA

In accordance with the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act, **all incoming travelers, regardless of nationality, shall be subject to mandatory 14-day quarantine** beginning on the date of entry and ending at 12:00 of the 15th day. (For example, if you arrived on 1 June, you are required to stay under mandatory quarantine until 12:00 of 15 June.) (\*The exact time may differ in the case of facility quarantine and will be announced by the quarantine facility.)

## **ONCE YOU ARRIVE AT AIRPORT**

Wear a facemask at all times and avoid contact or talking with other people.

You are required to be tested if you have suspected symptoms.

FOREIGNERS ON SHORT-TERM VISIT are required to enter mandatory quarantine (at their own expense) at a facility designated by the Korean government. ALL INCOMING TRAVELERS (regardless of point of origin or nationality) are required to receive a COVID-19 test. For travelers entering through Incheon International Airport,

you will get tested at an open walk-through screening station located at the airport during the hours 9:00-19:00 or at a temporary accommodation facility during 19:00-09:00.

Note) Those who have valid quarantine exemption are required to be tested and will be subject to active monitoring for 14 days by designated public health officials. The designated official will check and monitor their health conditions for 14 days.

\* Valid guarantine exemptions are:


- Pre-approved waiver from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; or
- A1 (diplomat on duty) or A2 (government official on duty) visa or a
- "quarantine exemption document" issued in advance by a Korean Embassy.

## FOREIGNERS ON LONG-TERM VISIT

(i.e. living in Korea) are required to enter mandatory quarantine in their homes.

If you do not have symptoms at the time of entry, you may leave the airport and enter your mandatory home quarantine. However, you are required to visit a screening center and get tested within the next 3 days (i.e. during your home quarantine period), regardless of symptoms. \* Further actions may follow contingent on test result.

FOR ALL PERSONS SUBJECT TO MANDATORY FACILITY QUARANTINE: - Use the designated transit vehicle to move to your designated quarantine facility.



#### **※** Failure to comply with this action may result in:

- Criminal penalty of imprisonment up to 1 year or a fine up to 10 million won according to Article 79-3, subparagraphs 3 through 5 of the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act;

 Civil damages in the event that your failure to comply constitutes violation of law and causes damage to the state due to further transmission of the infectious disease and/or additional measures of disease control/prevention; and/or
 (For foreign nationals) Revocation of visa or residence permit, deportation, and/or prohibition of entry according to the Immigration Act.
