
Notice for Fall 2022 Living Support Scholarship

1. Who to Apply: Full-time graduate students who enrolled at SNU in Fall 2022 and meet one of the following conditions

- 1) Students with financial difficulties who do academic work and infant care at the same time.
- 2) Students who are unable to continue their studies due to unaffordable medical expenses because of unexpected accident or disease (within 2 months based on the date of application)
- 3) Students with financial difficulties due to unexpected events in recent months
- 4) Foreign students who have no financial support from parents in the home country
 - parents' 2021 total annual income should be less than 50 Million Won (KRW)

2. Application Period : 2022. 8. 22.(Mon) ~ 8. 26.(Fri)

- 1) It is available to be overlapped with most of other living support scholarships (except 기초학문(특성별) 후속세대 장학금)
- 2) Exclusion from the selection if:
 - leave of absence (based on the date of selection and payment)
 - graduates
 - holdover
 - academic warning
 - disciplinary action
 - Other disqualifications

3. Scholarship Benefit : monthly payment of 500,000 Won (KRW)

- Support Period: One Semester(Fall 2022)
- Up to 3,000,000 Won (KRW) per person
- The payment will be provided around the 25th of every month

4. Documents to submit (*for those who are selected)

- 1) Scholarship application (write in mySNU scholarship apply page) <Required>
- 2) Certificate of family relationship (issued in your Country) <Required>

3) Document of 2021 Annual Income <Required>

- Unmarried: Parents and applicant
- Married: Spouse and applicant
- If family members do not have income, you should submit replacement document proving non-income.
- If family members have income in both Korea and another country, you should submit both documents.
- If you have income in Korea, you should submit ‘Certificate of Income (소득금액증명원)’
- If you do not have any income in 2021, you should submit ‘Proof of Non-Income(소득금액없음 사실증명원)’

4) Documents that can prove recent unexpected financial difficulty <Optional>

5) Certificates to prove your medical history within 2 months based on the date of application (e.g. Medical Certificate, Confirmation of Hospitalization Care, Medical Receipts, etc) <Optional>

6) Documents that can prove your grounds for the application of scholarship. <Optional>

※ All documents written in foreign language should be translated and notarized in Korean or English

Guideline of Applying for Living Support Scholarship

<Before the application, make sure to read the guideline below.>

Login to MySNU and Apply

1. Modification of application form is **only** available **during the application period.**
2. If you need to modify your application form or change the documents, you should cancel the application and re-apply in mySNU scholarship apply page **during the application period.**
3. Please be aware that you can be excluded from the recommendation list if you do not click 'Apply' button and just click 'Save Temporarily.'

Documents to submit

- **If documents are insufficient, it will be returned, so please be aware of the information below.**
1. For those who are unmarried, you should submit all the 'Document of 2021 Annual Income' of **himself/herself + parents.**
 2. For those who are married, you should submit all the 'Document of 2021 Annual Income' of **himself/herself + spouse.**
 3. The principle of attachment of your documents is **original scan.** But, if it is unavailable, please attach photo files that are identifiable.
 4. Every document **should be issued within the 3 months** based on the date of application.
 5. If you are going to submit documents which are issued in the foreign country, they should be translated and notarized in Korean or English.

Motivation Letter

1. Make sure to fill out the motivation letter. Otherwise, it will be returned.
2. It is a reference document for the selection, so fill it out as much detail as possible.

GPA Standards

1. The GPA Standards are not applied for Freshmen.
2. **Enrolled students** must have **over 2.4 of GPA** in the previous semester.

Payment

1. The scholarship will be paid around the 25th of every month in your bank account.
2. The bank account registered in mySNU personal information **must be valid bank account under your name.** (If not, the payment is unavailable.)
